Cochin Chickens are known for their very soft feathers and fluffy appearance. They have a profusion of long, soft plumage that makes them seem larger than they actually are. Cochins have round bodies, a single comb, and feathered feet. They lay a fair number of brown or tinted eggs. Cochins are very broody and are often used to hatch out fertile eggs from other birds.

Average mature weight: roosters 11 lbs.; hens 8 lbs.

* The color blue does not breed true. The chicks hatched from these chickens can be blue, black, or splash.
