

Rudd Rangers (Straight Run)



These meat birds were name after the little town of Rudd, Iowa. This "haus" loves to free range and finishes out slower than the Cornish Cross Broiler, but the wait is worth it! The Rudd Ranger is a versatile bird that can be raised in more confined areas or in free-range environments but prefers the latter. Just like the Rudd residents, these birds are docile and get along with most other breeds. They have red plumage with

dark tail and wing feathers. When dressed, the Rudd Ranger's body is more proportional compared to a broiler, making the dark meat almost equal the breast meat.
